## Parish Council News

### Changes to the 22 Bus Service

**Nottinghamshire County Council have been in negotiations with Trent Barton concerning the continuation of the 22 bus service to and from Nottingham.**

They have now agreed a new timetable that took effect from Tuesday 29th May 2007 and runs until Saturday 27th October. The Saturday service will be restored and two evening services from Nottingham will be available on request using the Cotgrave Connection service. Copies of the proposed new timetable have been posted on the parish notice boards in both Barnstone and Langar. Currently NCC are not proposing to provide a timetabled Sunday service, but instead are exploring the option of a Demand Responsive Transport facility, which would necessitate passengers pre-booking their journey. More information on this should be available shortly.

Leicestershire County Council have declined to offer any financial subsidy to Trent Barton for the 22 service and so the service will now not be available to those Vale of Belvoir villages that fall within the Leicestershire county boundary.

Again NCC has advised us that the continuation of the 22 service and any Sunday transport facility in this area will heavily depend on its utilisation. Representatives from the parishes affected by this service will be asked to discuss with NCC and Trent Barton representatives what services may be offered from 27th October 2007 onwards.

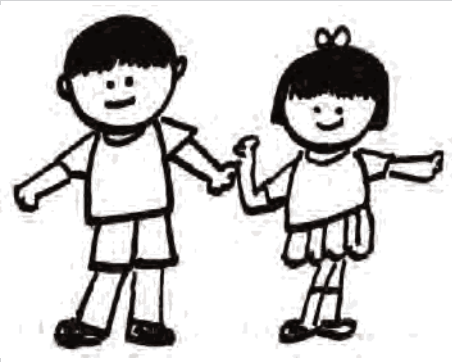

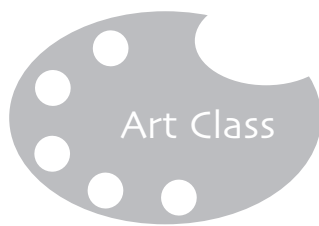

## Nottinghamshire Young Farmers Clubs

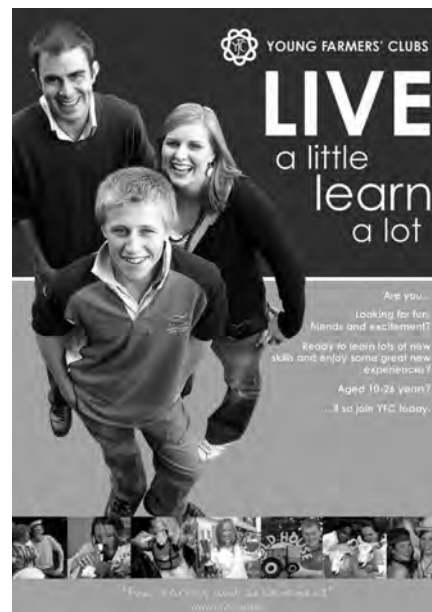
The YFC movement provides social & personal development for young people between the ages of 14 - 26, with numerous competitions, sports activities & events at a local-club, county & national level.
